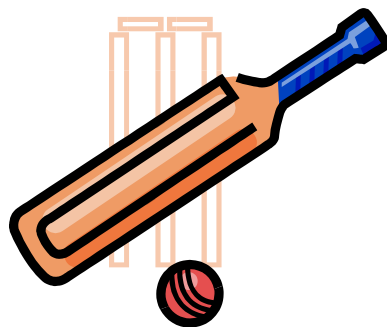

Under 11's Premier's 2004/05

From when the boys bowled the first ball to when the last wicket was taken for the season I did not know that we would walk away with the premiership victory so easily this year. I put down our success for this year and last year as to the boys playing in all senses of the word as a team. That to me is what our team really was this year, a champion team, not teams of individuals, as they all really work very well together. I can say that not once this year at training or at a game did I ever hear the boys putting down anyone in the team for their ability. They all got behind each other with praise and encouragement. This developed a lot of self-belief in the team for all of the boys and everyone else who was around the team.

Our season this year had a lot of highlights with everybody contributing to the team in some way whether with bat or ball. We had some very high team scores with the one that was our best of 333 against North Richmond. In that game Jacob made our top score of 76 not out and Jackson also scored 34 not out. In our first game for the year Hayden scored 57 not out who was also backed up by Paul with 40 not out. Ben also had a good run with the bat scoring a string of 38 not out 3 times. Brendan and Lachlan also put some good scores on the board for us this year but for these two guys I felt that they made their presences felt more with the ball. Brendan, Paul, Jacob and Ben were our pace bowling attack for the year with all ripping oppositions apart with fast and tight bowling.

Lachlan and Jason became our spin-bowling twins this year and I hope that they both stick with it as they both show a lot of ability and promise. Lachlan just started to bowl spin at training one night when he got a bit tired and he could land it straight on the spot, this impressed me a great deal. Lachlan also took some good wickets and he was the one factor that helped us to an outright win against Schofields with 4 for 10. Lachlan just bamboozled them they could not read him as he bowled both leg break and off spin in the one over. I will say that all of the bowlers did things this year that just blew me away but my bowling highlight will be Jason who just started to bowl leg spin the week of the Grand Final. Jason had not really tried to bowl the leggies all year and to come on in the Grand Final and just plain mesmerise the batsmen taking 2 crucial wickets will stay with me for a long time.

We had two new players to our team this year in Justin and Nicholas I hope that both of them will be back again next season as I feel that they both can be good players. Justin has shown a lot of promise with the role of wicketkeeper and with some more training could turn out to be great wicketkeeper if he puts in the effort and extra work needed for this role. Nicholas this season showed me that he really does have a great pair of hands and could catch anything that came at him. I feel that Nicholas could turn out to be a great slips fielder as he make it look easy and does have natural talent which will help him go places. Nicholas, who did not know any of the boys before coming to play for us this year, just fitted into the team so well which helped keep the team balanced.

My highlight of the year for the team will be a score of 11 by Cameron. I will never forget the look on his face when he lined one ball up and just smashed it. He ran down the pitch jumping up and punching into the air looking so happy like he had just scored 100 with that shot. I could see just how much that one shot had meant to him and that is what I love about coaching and what I love about this game we call cricket.

I could just keep writing page after page about these boys who I had the great privilege to coach for the last two seasons. I also do not just consider them as the boys in cricket team but as my friends as well and I am so proud of each and every one of them. So I say thank you to all of the boys and also to all of the parents for bringing them to training and waiting for us to finish and also being up early each Saturday and helping me out with scoring, umpiring and running of the team. Without all of you helping it would not have been the year that it was.

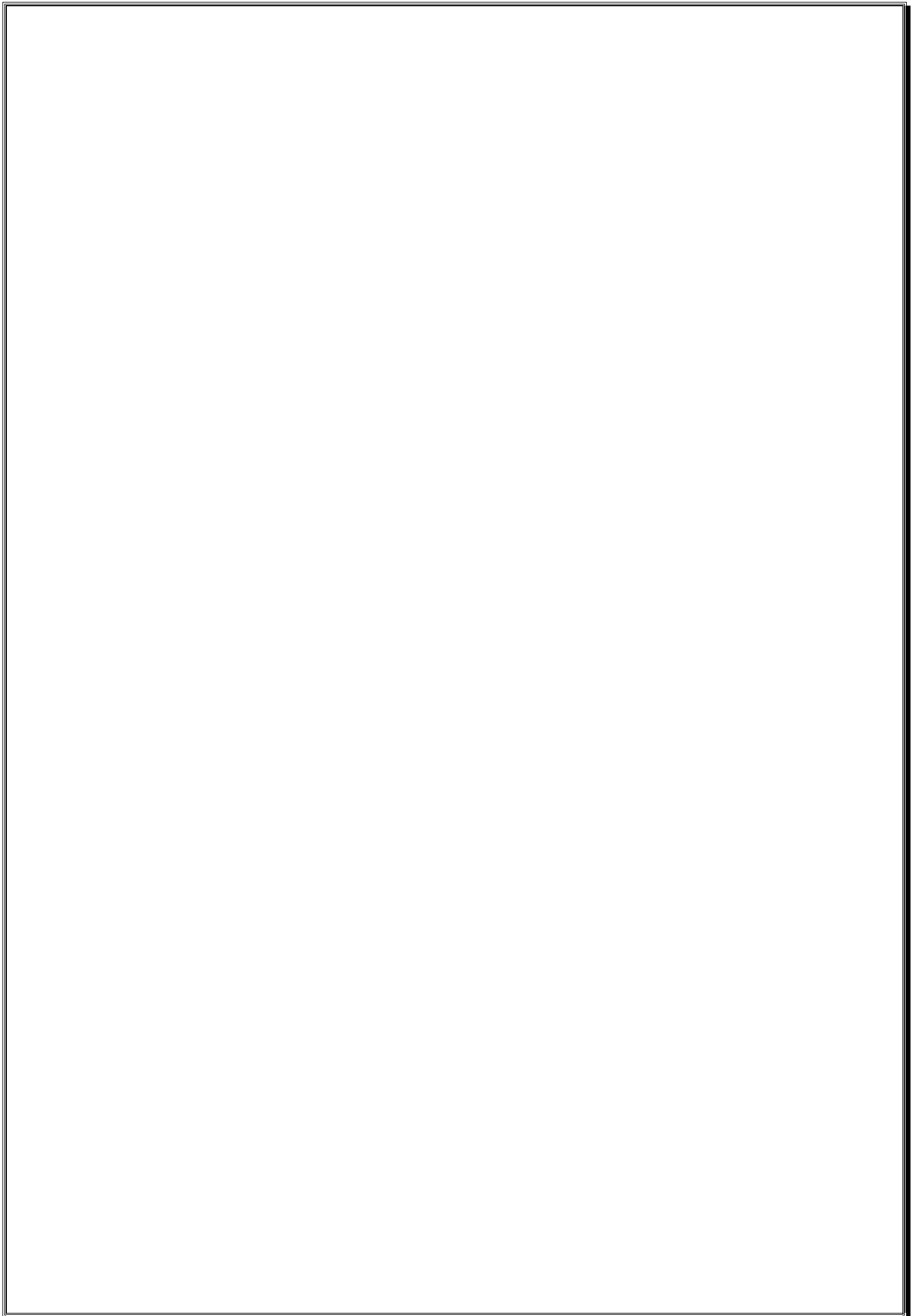

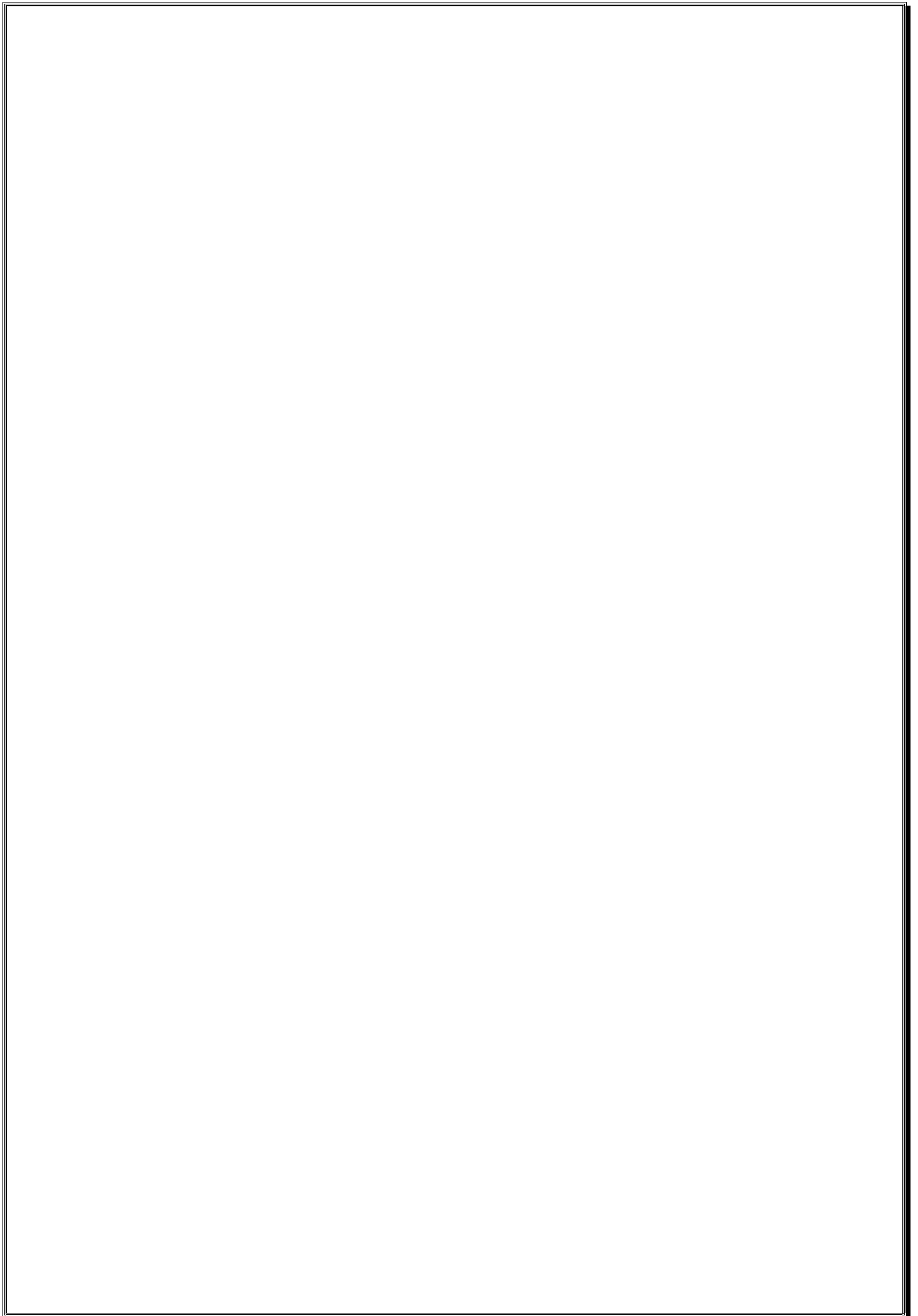
